## Dyslexia/Dyspraxia Policy

With reference to the NET Equal Opportunities Policy, the NET policy for AM2 candidates with dyslexia and/or dyspraxia is as follows:

The candidate needs to supply evidence that they have been assessed for dyslexia and/or dyspraxia, in advance of carrying out the AM2 Assessment. Candidates cannot have any additional assessment time for sections A1, A, B or C. However, they can ask for the clock to be stopped at any point to allow them to read and understand written instructions. So for example, a candidate is allocated a maximum time of 8.5 hours for section A, but with stopped time this could be extended to say 10 hours. Candidates are allowed to have a reader present at all times, however, the reader must not be electrotechnically competent or have undertaken an AM2.

Section D Online Exam – AM2 support should be notified and a provision will be set up for each question to be paused. Candidates can be given an additional 25% of time for this section.
