FAQ's

Q1 I want to join a Part P Competent Person Scheme and I already hold a Full Scope Part P Certificate, do I need any other qualifications?

A Yes, There has been a change in the Competent Person Scheme entry requirements and all operatives must hold a valid BS 7671 17th Edition Wiring Regulations qualification; for instance the City & Guilds 2382-10, but this qualification only deals with the theory requirements of the 17th Edition Wiring Regulations. As part of the inspection process you will be expected to also demonstrate competence in the practical areas of electrical installation in domestic dwellings including inspection, testing and certification all of which is covered within the Full Scope Part P course.



Q2 Do houses still need an Energy Performance Certificates when being sold?

A The short answer is yes. Although the coalition government scrapped the Home Information Pack (HIP) as soon as they entered parliament, the requirement for every property sold in England and Wales to have a current Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) still remains, although it would now be carried out when the property has been sold rather than when the house was put on the market. It is also a requirement for every landlord to provide a current EPC when letting or renting a property. All of this is covered in the City & Guilds 6020-01 Qualification for Domestic Energy Assessors.



Q3 I work with refrigeration equipment currently, when do I need to have the new F-gas Qualification?

A By 4th July 2011, it will be a legal requirement for those organisations or companies working with fluorinated gases to hold a full Company Certificate through the bodies appointed by Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (Defra). To obtain a stationary equipment company certificate (Full Certificate) businesses must prove that each employed engineer carrying out SRAC work holds a recognised industry qualification in the handling of F Gases which includes the City & Guilds 2079.



Need an OFTEC OIL qualification? ...then give our Basildon Centre a call!

On the 5th July OFTEC introduced a new suite of assessment paperwork for the ever popular 101, 102 105E, 600A assessments. At the same time OFTEC took the opportunity to revise the training books for each subject and bring them up to date with all the new standards and regulations.

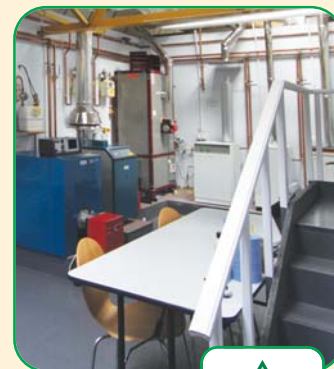
Logic4training at Basildon has been successfully running the new assessment suite for its customers and has also taken into stock the new manuals, which are available to candidates to buy during their training or before if required. The reference numbers have changed slightly for each assessment that is available through Basildon as below:

OFT10-101 Servicing & Commissioning Pressure Jet Appliances

OFT10-105E Domestic oil firing system installation

OFT10-600a Domestic & Non-Domestic oil storage & supply installation

Once the assessments have been completed the candidate can then register with OFTEC as a Technician, and will then be able to self certify and register all installations. OFTEC will also issue an identity card with the Technicians relevant qualifications listed on the reverse. LUTON Centre is approved to offer AM2 Electrical Assessment



At the beginning of July this year the Logic4training centre at Luton started to deliver its first AM2 electrical assessment as an NET Approved AM2 Assessment centre. The AM2 assessment forms the final part of the apprenticeship framework and must be undertaken by all apprentices in order to complete their apprenticeship and start in the industry as a qualified electrician. The AM2 assessment can be broken in to 4 sections which are undertaken over 2½ days.

- Section A1 – Safe Isolation Procedures (1 hour)
- Section A – Installation task (7.5 hours)
- Section B – Inspection and Testing (3.5 hours)
- Section C – Fault Diagnosis (2 hours)
- Section D – Online Knowledge Test (1 hour)

To support the launch of the Luton AM2 assessment centre an open day was held for all the colleges in the surrounding area that offered electro-technical NVQ's and we had over the 30 people attend.

If a candidate is in need of some refresher training before undertaking this AM2 assessment, this is catered for at Luton and covers inspection, testing, certification, fault finding and installation of various electrical systems and components. As part of this all candidates must have completed the AM2 self assessment check list which can be provided by our team.

Solar Photovoltaics: The POWER to make a difference.

Since April 2010 when the Feed in Tariff (FiT) for generating your own electricity from renewable means i.e. Solar Photovoltaics was introduced, the demand for LOGIC Certification Solar Photovoltaic Installer Course has taken off with over 100 operatives already trained and ready to start down the road to becoming an MCS accredited Solar Photovoltaic Installer.



At the moment your customers can benefit from a rate of 41.3p/kWh generated by the installation plus, an extra payment of at least 3p/kWh for any electricity not used and exported to the grid; this rate is guaranteed for 25 years. Both these payments are on top of the saving that could be made by the customer offsetting the current electricity usage that they pay for now. All in all it is an exceptional deal for the householder that is thought to provide a return on investment of at least 12%, with some customers estimating that their initial investment will have been recouped within 8-10 years providing an additional 15 years of return.

Key to this is becoming a member of a Microgeneration Certification Scheme (MCS) registration body, as the consumer will only be allowed to gain access to the FiT funding if both the installer and the product is registered under the MCS Scheme.



All of these subjects are covered in the LOGIC Certification Solar Photovoltaic Installer Course in addition to the practical and design skills required to fit a Solar PV system, so to start your business down this route call our **Customer Services Team** on **0845 845 7222**.

F-Gas & ODS deadline is looming! Will you be ready by
July 4th 2011 when the legal requirements kick in?**

Logic4training can now offer you the City & Guilds 2079-11 Level 2 Certificate in F-Gas and ODS Regulations course, so you can be qualified to work with these gases by July 2011's deadline!

This qualification is for those working within the refrigeration and air-conditioning industry who will need to meet the legal requirements for working with Fluorinated Gases, otherwise known as F-Gas and other Ozone Depleting Substances (ODS). The course also covers brazing of pipework. This package is a five day course, and is for those customers wishing to be covered for all four categories including leak checking, refrigeration recovery, service/maintenance and installation.



For those EXPERIENCED operatives who are fully conversant with Ph Charts, basic principles of vapour compression system, subcooling and superheating and practical application of these principles on refrigeration systems we run a specific 3 day course.
