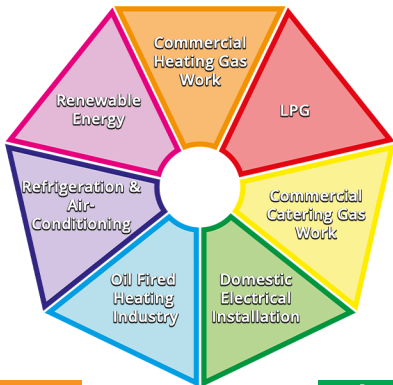


Domestic Gas Engineers Upskilling Options



Commercial Heating Gas Work

1. Commercial Heating Upskill Package:
This course is for operatives who have little or no experience on commercial heating gas work and are doing a Commercial Gas Heating course for the first time.

2. Commercial Heating Changeover Package:
This course is for operatives who have experience on commercial heating gas work. This is more suitable for operatives coming back for their 5 yearly reassessments. Candidates must maintain a valid Domestic Gas ACS for this course.

Note: Both Commercial and Domestic ACS qualifications have to be renewed every 5 years to be able to continue working on commercial properties in the Commercial Heating Upskill and Changeover package above.

3. Core Commercial Heating Gas Safety Package:
This course is for operatives who are renewing their commercial qualifications and do not envisage working on domestic gas any more or have only ever worked on commercial gas work.

1. Oil Firing Introductory Course (OFT50)
This introductory OFTEC Oil Fired Training Course is aimed at new entrants to the oil fired heating industry with minimal or no prior experience. The course prepares candidates to undertake the full 4 day Oil Boiler Package below.

2. Oil Boiler Package Course

This course is a necessary requirement for installers and maintenance technicians requiring OFTEC registration. This training package covers Domestic/light commercial pressure jet appliance commissioning & oil boiler servicing, Domestic oil firing installation & energy conservation measures in buildings and Domestic & non-domestic oil boiler storage installation and supply.

1. Basic F-Gas Refrigeration Course

This is a comprehensive course providing a basic understanding of Refrigeration and Air Conditioning fundamentals, terminology and equipment application. It is a useful preparatory training for a Category 1, F-Gas Certification Course (which is a mandatory requirement to work with F-Gases).
